The initiative encompasses a wide range of focus areas, including Safety & Security, Outdoor Learning & Playgrounds, Internal Learning Environments, Athletics, Technology, and Building Systems.

The cornerstone of this initiative is the \$15 million general obligation bond, which was approved by voters in May, providing critical capital improvement funding over the next four years. These funds, combined with the ongoing mill levy funds that were approved by voters in 2019, allow APS to deliver optimal educational spaces for its students.

The Capital Projects and Construction website is designed to empower the community by offering insights into APS's project selection process and timelines. Key considerations for project prioritization include:

- **Security**: Ensuring the safety of students and staff remains paramount.
- **Minimal Disruptions**: Striving to minimize disruptions to the learning environment.
- Value Maximization: Leveraging additional funding sources such as state grants and local resources.
- **Cost-Effectiveness**: Rigorously vetting options to ensure the best value for investments.
- **Efficiency**: Exploring economies of scale and the availability of local contractors.
- **Planning and Design**: Accounting for permitting, architectural designs, and other logistical factors.
- Needs vs. Wants: Thoughtfully balancing essential needs with desirable enhancements.

"We understand the importance of making informed decisions when it comes to shaping the educational spaces that nurture our students' growth," stated Judy Rabon, School Board President at APS. "By providing transparent and real-time information, we hope to foster a collaborative spirit among our community members and stakeholders."
